Reception to Year 5 Swimming Program

When:

Monday August 21st to Friday August 25th

Where:

North Adelaide Aquatic Centre
Qualified swimming Instructors work with the children.

Cost:

\$20 per student for the whole 5 days. This pays for instructors, pool entry and bus. Payment arrangements can be made.

Who:

For all Reception to Year 5 students

Swimming is part of the PE curriculum and an important part of the school program.

We have subsidised the fee by almost 50% for each child, therefore it is expected that all children will take part.
